## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 92-91

# APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE CAMBRIA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT TREATMENT FACILITIES UPGRADE AND EXPANSION

#### WHEREAS:

- The State Water Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- 2. The State Water Board, on September 17, 1992, adopted the FFY 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Cambria Community Services District (District) sewage treatment plant improvement project;
- 3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the draft revenue program for the sewage treatment plant improvement and expansion project;
- 4. There are sufficient SRF loan funds available from loan repayments to adequately fund the project; and
- 5. The information contained in the EIR (State Clearinghouse No. 91021017) prepared for the project, has been reviewed and considered and it has been determined that:
  - (a) Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into the project, which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR with respect to the following aspects of the project: (i) Erosion effects will be mitigated by implementation of an erosion control plan; (ii) impacts to cultural resources will be mitigated by stopping construction if cultural resources are encountered and using a qualified archeologist to identify areas to avoid, evaluate sites, and develop mitigation programs; (iii) if paleontological resources are discovered, they will be mitigated by halting construction until a qualified paleontologist can develop a plan for the identification, cataloging, curation, and storage of material collected.
  - (b) With respect to other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR, appropriate changes or alterations are within the jurisdiction of other public agencies. Such other changes or alterations have been adopted or should be adopted by such other agencies.

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approves a SRF loan of \$2.0 million from the SRF loan repayment fund, for the Cambria Community Services District's sewage treatment plant upgrade and expansion, Project No. C-06-4108-110, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after construction is completed.
