## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 92-92

# APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BRET HARTE SEWER SYSTEM

### WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- The State Water Board, on September 17, 1992, adopted the FFY 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Bret Harte project;
- 3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and revenue program for this project;
- 4. There are sufficient SRF loan funds available from loan repayments to adequately fund the project;
- 5. The Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors approved the Negative Declaration for the proposed project (State Clearinghouse No. 92032082) which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Board, and it has been determined that the proposed project will not result in significant negative environmental impacts.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approve an SRF loan of \$3.0 million to Stanislaus County for the construction of sewer lines for the unsewered community of Bret Harte from the SRF loan repayment, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first loan repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.
