RESOLUTION NO. 92-95

RESCIND AUTHORIZATION OF A STATE  
REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN TO  
PANOCHÉ DRAINAGE DISTRICT (DISTRICT)

WHEREAS:

1. The District was authorized a \$450,000 SRF loan for a irrigation improvement project by Resolution No. 91-24.
2. On August 12, 1992, the District sent a letter requesting they be removed from the list of applicants for loans.
3. On September 17, 1992, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) removed the District from the Federal Fiscal Year 1993 Priority List.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to remove the Panoche Drainage District Irrigation Improvement Project.
2. That the State Water Board rescind authorization for the SRF loan of \$450,000 to Panoche Drainage District.

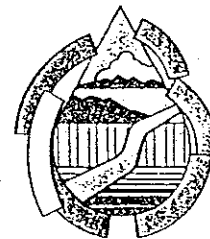
