RESOLUTION NO. 92-97

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
FOR TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION OF WASTEWATER
TREATMENT PLANT OPERATORS AND SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS:

1. Section 3718, Chapter 4, Title 23, Subchapter 14 of the California Administrative Code provides for a nine-member Advisory Committee appointed pursuant to Section 13631 of the Water Code.
2. The terms of four of the nine-member committee expired on June 30, 1992.
3. Two of the remaining five members of the committee whose terms expire on June 30, 1994 have resigned.

For the period beginning July 1, 1990 and ending July 30, 1994.


1. Representing local sanitation agencies, other than municipalities:
