RESOLUTION NO. 93-4

APPROVAL OF STATE WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND
ABATEMENT ACCOUNT FUNDS FOR WALKER MINE TAILINGS:
DOLLY CREEK STABILIZATION - PHASE I

WHEREAS:

1. Plumas County Community Development Commission (Commission) has accumulated \$197,400 from the Plumas National Forest, Pacific Gas and Electric, and State Water Resources Control Board 319 grant program for erosion control of stream banks along Dolly Creek; and
2. The Commission has requested that the above amount be supplemented by \$50,000 from the Cleanup and Abatement Account; and
3. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region believes the project should have a direct impact on reducing the discharge of contaminants to both Dolly and Little Grizzly Creek, and the project will also complement the acid mine drainage measures implemented at Walker Mine.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board hereby approves up to \$50,000 from the State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account to help fund the Walker Mine tailings: Dolly Creek Stabilization - Phase I project.
