RESOLUTION NO. 93-46

APPROVAL OF STATE WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT FUNDS
TO COMPLETE THE INVESTIGATIVE PHASE AND
ISSUE THE "TECHNOLOGY EVALUATION REPORT" FOR PENN MINE

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board Resolution No. 90-50 provides \$300,000 to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Water Quality Control Board) to pay for design of pollution abatement measures at the Penn Mine site;
2. The Regional Water Quality Control Board initiated a contract with Davy Environmental, in December 1991, to complete the work listed in Resolution No. 90-50;
3. For various reasons the investigative phase of the contract cannot be completed within the funds allocated for the project;
4. The Regional Water Quality Control Board has requested \$123,000 from the State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account (Account) to augment the funds provided by Resolution No. 90-50;
5. The additional funds will be used to complete the investigation phase and "Technology Evaluation Report", which will include sufficient information to select the cleanup- alternative; and
6. The investigation phase will be completed by July 1993.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board hereby approves the Regional Water Quality Control Board's request for \$123,000 from the State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account to augment the funds provided in State Water Board Resolution No. 90-50.
