RESOLUTION NO. 93-71

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE
SAN ELIJO JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY WATER RECLAMATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990 and January 21, 1993;
2. The State Water Board, on September 17, 1992, adopted the FFY 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the San Elijo Joint Powers Authority Water Reclamation System;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and revenue program for the Water Reclamation System project; and
4. The San Elijo Joint Powers Authority has certified an EIR (State Clearinghouse No. 92091009) for the proposed project which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Board, and it has been determined that:
 - (a) Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into the proposed project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental effects identified in the EIR with respect to: (i) water quality impacts will be mitigated by properly disposing of dewatering effluent, and double sandbagging and revegetating to prevent erosion and sedimentation; (ii) public health impacts from the use of chlorine will be mitigated by using a leak detection system, containing spills, using air scrubbers, preparing an emergency response plan, and properly training operators; (iii) cultural and paleontological resources impacts will be mitigated by testing known sites prior to issuance of a loan, having an archaeological and paleontologist present during trenching, and conducting a data recovery program if significant resources are found.
 - (b) With respect to other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies. Such other changes or alterations have been adopted or should be adopted by such other agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approves a State Revolving Fund loan of \$12.21 million for the San Elijo Joint Powers Authority Reclaimed Water System project, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first loan repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.
