RESOLUTION NO. 93-102

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING LOAN  
TO THE CITY OF WASCO  
SRF PROJECT NO. C-6021-110

WHEREAS:


1. The City of Wasco (City) has requested a \$481,800 loan from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for the construction of a storm water retention pond and storm drainage pipe extension.
2. The City has certified a Negative Declaration in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act. As this project is not a Tier II (i.e., equivalency) project, compliance with the requirements of the State Environmental Review Process is not required.
3. The project is consistent with the directives issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region.
4. The project will be effective in the prevention of future contamination to ground water resulting from storm water drainage at the Wasco Solid Waste Disposal Site.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Intended Use Plan is amended to include the City of Wasco storm water retention pond project.
2. The Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the City of Wasco storm water retention pond project.
3. The SRF loan of \$481,800 is approved for the City of Wasco.
4. The repayment period for the City of Wasco is 20 years.
5. The first repayment is due one year after the completion of construction.
