# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 94-34

# APPROVAL TO AWARD A SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT TO THE CITY OF SHASTA LAKE FOR THE COMMUNITIES OF PINE GROVE AND PROJECT CITY

#### WHEREAS:

- The City of Shasta Lake, on behalf of the Communities of Pine Grove and Project City has requested grant funds for the construction of improvements to its wastewater treatment plant;
- 2. The projects have been included on the State Board's Small Community Grant Project Priority List;
- The Community of Pine Grove has a population of 1,100 people, and a median household income of \$21,000 per year;
- 4. The Community of Project City has a population of 2,000 people and a median household income of \$17,500 per year;
- The Division of Clean Water Programs has issued concept approval and has approved the plans and specifications for the proposed project;
- 6. The estimated State grant amount for City of Shasta Lake is \$4.0 million; and
- 7. The City of Shasta Lake has certified an EIR for the proposed project (State Clearinghouse No. 91023048) which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Resources Control Board and we have determined that:
  - Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into (a) the project which avoid or lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR to less than significant levels with respect to the following aspects of the project: (i) erosion effects which will be mitigated by implementing an erosion control and revegetation plan, scheduling major construction for the dry season and using construction setbacks and restrictions along riparian corridors; (ii) to cultural resources which will be mitigated by stopping construction if cultural resources are encountered and using a qualified archeologist to identify areas to avoid, evaluating sites, and developing mitigation programs; (iii) impacts to paleontological resources, which if discovered, will be mitigated by halting construction until a qualified paleontologist can develop a plan for the identification, cataloging, curation, and storage of material collected.

(b) With respect to other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR, appropriate changes or alterations are not within the jurisdiction of the State Water Resources Control Board. Such other changes or alterations have been adopted or should be adopted by other agencies.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board:

- Has determined that the City of Shasta Lake is eligible for grants under the Clean Water and Water Reclamation Bond Law of 1988; and
- 2. Approves the award of Small Community Grant of \$4.0 million for the City of Shasta Lake that includes \$2.0 million for the Community of Pine Grove and \$2.0 million for the Community of Project City for the construction of improvement at the City of Shasta Lake wastewater treatment plant.
