RESOLUTION NO. 94-96

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN TO  
THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY WATER AGENCY  
(LOAN NO. C-06-6028-110)

WHEREAS:


1. The Sacramento County Water Agency (SCWA) has requested a \$7,461,400 State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan for a Detention Basins for Stormwater Runoff project.
2. The project is in conformance with the Strawberry and Jacinto Creeks Drainage Master Plan adopted by the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors and the SCWA and has obtained an Environmental Impact Report to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act.
3. The SRF will fund only the detention basins used for water quality or for dual-purpose water quality/flood control which are designed to comply with the County's NPDES permit.
4. The project will minimize the impacts from high frequency, low intensity stormwater flows from future developments.
5. There is presently a funding cap of \$5 million which will be increased as more funds become available.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. An SRF loan of \$5 million, with total funding up to \$7,461,400 if the funding cap for Federal Fiscal Year 1995 is raised, is approved for the Sacramento County Water Agency.
2. The loan term is twenty years.
3. The first repayment is due one year after the first disbursement of loan funds.
