

# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 95-6

## APPOINTMENT OF ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Senate Bill 1764 (Chapter 1191 of the Statutes of 1994) requires the Board to convene, on or before February 1, 1995, an advisory committee of distinguished chemists, biologists, health professionals, geologists, engineers and other professionals.
- 2. The law requires that the committee conduct a comprehensive review of: groundwater monitoring requirements, remediation techniques, and methodologies; cri7teria for determining that remediation has been satisfactorily completed; cleanup standards which responsible parties conducting corrective action are required to meet; and policies, guidelines, and methods which are used to establish those standards.
- 3. On or before September 1, 1995, the advisory committee shall recommend to the Board any changes which it believes are appropriate to ensure that cleanup standards are both technologically feasible and necessary to ensure the protection of human health and safety and the environment; and
