STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 95-38

ACCEPTANCE OF \$395,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) TO CARRY OUT ACTIVITIES FOR NEW RIVER POLLUTION ABATEMENT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Improvement of New River water quality is a high priority of the State Water Board;
- 2. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has allocated 27.5 million dollars for New River pollution abatement projects;
- 3. \$395,000 is available from the EPA for State and Regional Board activities on New River pollution abatement projects;
- 4. The State Water Board will provide technical and program support; and
- 5. The Colorado River Basin Regional Water Quality Control Board will conduct a sampling program on the New River.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board hereby authorizes the Executive Director to apply for and accept \$395,000 from the EPA to fund State and Regional Water Board staff costs associated with New River pollution abatement projects.
