APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ESTABLISHMENT OF A LINKED
DEPOSIT PROGRAM WITH STATE REVOLVING FUNDS (SRF) TO ASSIST THE
COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ FOR REPAIR OF INDIVIDUAL SEPTIC SYSTEMS

WHEREAS:

1. The County of Santa Cruz (County) has applied for a \$2,217,500 SRF linked deposit program to provide assistance to individual landowners with failing or substandard septic systems that are causing a public health hazard.
2. The County has performed an economic analysis and determined that individual septic repair is more cost effective than a valleywide sewer system.
3. The County has completed a Negative Declaration to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act on April 6, 1995.
4. The County has completed the "Wastewater Management Plan For The San Lorenzo River Watershed" which was approved by the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board by Resolution No. 95-04, April 14, 1995.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The SWRCB approves establishment of a \$2,217,500 linked deposit program to provide assistance for the Repair of Individual Septic Systems.
