STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 96-2

RESCINDING THE LAKE TAHOE BASIN WATER QUALITY PLAN

WHEREAS:

- Lake Tahoe is located in both the States of California and Nevada, and responsibility for its protection is jointly shared by those States and the bi-state Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA).
- 2. The States of California and Nevada have designated TRPA as the water quality management agency for the Lake Tahoe Region under Section 208 of the Federal Clean Water Act.
- 3. The Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan (Lake Tahoe Plan) was adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) in 1980 and amended in 1989.
- 4. TRPA adopted its bi-State Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Management Plan (208 Plan) in 1981, and revised it in 1988. The revisions were certified by the SWRCB in 1989 under Resolution No. 89-32.
- 5. SWRCB Resolution No. 89-32 also stated the SWRCB's intent to consider rescission of the Lake Tahoe Plan upon incorporation of the appropriate water quality control measures into the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board (LRWQCB) Water Quality Control Plan (Basin Plan).
- 6. In October 1994, the LRWQCB completed revision of the Basin Plan including incorporation of the appropriate water quality control measures from both the Lake Tahoe Plan and the revised TRPA 208 Plan.
- 7. The revised Basin Plan was approved by the SWRCB under Resolution No. 95-3 in January 1995 and by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) in March 1995.
- 8. The SWRCB stated in Resolution No. 89-32 and in Resolution No. 95-3 its intent to consider rescission of the Lake Tahoe Plan after incorporation of the appropriate control measures from the Lake Tahoe Plan and the TRPA 208 Plan into the LRWQCB Basin Plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The SWRCB rescinds the Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan.
