WHEREAS:


- 1 The *Implementation Policy for the Small Communities Grant Program* was adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board on January 23, 1997, and amended and reauthorized on June 15, 2000;
- 2 The State Water Resources Control Board, on August 17, 2000, adopted the SCG Program Priority List that included the District's Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements project, in Priority Class B;
- 3 The Division of Clean Water Programs (Division) approved the Facilities Plan, which includes the project report, environmental documents, and draft revenue program, on June 1, 1998, for the District's Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements project;
- 4 The Division approved the Final Plans and Specifications on May 10, 1999, for the District's Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements project; and
- 5 The North Marin Water District has filed a Notice of Exemption which has been reviewed and considered and it has been determined that the project qualifies for a Class 2 and a Class 4 Categorical Exemption from CEQA requirements and will not result in any significant environmental impacts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board approves a Small Communities Grant of \$263,110 to the Tomales Village Community Services District for construction of the Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements project.
