**Subject:** 2/2/16 BOARD MEETING (Conservation Extended Emergency Regulation)

We are customers of the San Juan Water District.

Recently, we learned that the State Water Resources Control Board will vote on February 2, 2016 to continue the existing emergency water conservation regulations. The State Board's draft regulations require San Juan Water District to continue conserving at a 33 percent reduction over 2013 water use. This is a three percent decrease since a 36 percent reduction was mandated in June 2015.

We both have had a working life in the water arena, in both public and private roles. We are writing because we are opposed to having the 33 percent conservation requirement considered in early February. We feel it is far too high due to winter weather storms we have experienced, snow in the Sierras and recurrent rain. We believe that conservation requirements should be reevaluated in April when the water supply conditions are better known.
