Subject: 2/2/16 BOARD MEETING (Conservation Extended Emergency Regulation)

The State Board's draft regulations require San Juan Water District to continue conserving at a 33 percent reduction over 2013 water use. As long time residents of Granite Bay, my husband and I agree with San Juan Water District's opposition to having the 33 percent conservation requirement considered in early February. It is far too high due to the extremely positive impact from the snow in the Sierras and recurrent rain in the hills and valleys, both experienced as well as further forecasted. Conservation requirements should be reevaluated in April when the water supply conditions are better known, particularly under significantly improving conditions. A 60 day deferral of an evaluation and decision seems wise and appropriate in these conditions.
