Subject: 2/2/16 BOARD MEETING (Conservation Extended Emergency Regulation)

The State Board's draft regulations require San Juan Water District to continue conserving at a 33 percent reduction over 2013 water use. This is a three percent decrease since a 36 percent reduction was mandated in June 2015.

As a San Juan Water District customer, we have worked hard to help achieve the 36 percent conservation regulation. Unfortunately, we fell short most recently in December reaching a 26.4 percent savings compared to 2013 water use.

I am opposed to having the 33 percent conservation requirement being considered in early February. I feel it is far too high a requirement due to winter weather storms we have experienced, snow in the Sierras and recurrent rain.

I believe conservation requirements should be reevaluated in April when the water supply conditions are better known.
