NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL COASTAL BASIN TO INCORPORATE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS FOR TURBIDITY IN THE GABILAN CREEK WATERSHED, MONTEREY COUNTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will consider adopting a resolution approving the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region's (Central Coast Water Board) amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin (Basin Plan) establishing total maximum daily loads for turbidity in the Gabilan Creek watershed, Monterey County (Basin Plan amendment). The Central Coast Water Board adopted the Basin Plan amendment on February 18, 2022 (Resolution No. R3-2022-0002).
