BACKGROUND

The CWSRF Policy was written to implement the federal Clean Water Act’s CWSRF Program in California. The CWSRF Policy sets forth the requirements to obtain CWSRF and complementary financing.

The CWSRF Policy was last amended on December 3, 2019. Since then, demand on the CWSRF Program has greatly increased, and changes to priority scoring criteria are being proposed by the Division of Financial Assistance to better manage the increased demand. Additional changes are also being proposed to better manage the credit evaluation process and to improve consistency between the CWSRF and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Policies.
