Notice of Document Availability and Opportunity to Comment and Notice of Board Hearing and Notice of Staff-Hosted Public Workshop for the Review of State Water Quality Control Plans and State Policies for Water Quality Control

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) has released for public review and comment a Revised Draft Staff Report and Workplan for the Review of State Water Quality Control Plans and State Policies for Water Quality Control (Review of State Plans and Policies). The purpose of the Review of State Plans and Policies is to assess the adequacy of state plans and policies, as well as other applicable water quality standards and criteria, to help guide the State Water Board's priorities for future projects to establish or amend plans and policies.

The State Water Board will hold a public hearing to receive comments on the Review of State Plans and Policies, including the Revised Draft Staff Report and Work Plan. State Water Board staff will also host a public workshop to provide information and answer questions on the Review of State Plans and Policies.

Background

State plans and policies contain water quality standards and other provisions established by the State Water Board to preserve and enhance California's waters to safeguard human health, support aquatic ecosystems, improve the quality of water resources, and protect beneficial uses of waters. The State Water Board conducts triennial reviews of state plans and periodic reviews of state policies. The purpose of the review is to assess the adequacy of state plans and policies, as well as other applicable water quality standards and criteria, to help guide the State Water Board's priorities for future amendments to state plans and policies, as described in the [Notice of Commencement of Review of State Plans and Policies](#).

The State Water Board is conducting its triennial review of state plans and periodic review of state policies in a single combined proceeding. The state plans and policies and other applicable water quality standards and criteria that are being reviewed as part of this project are described in the [Notice of Commencement of Review of State Plans and Policies](#). This review is not a rulemaking. Any future amendments of state plans or policies are subject to separate rulemaking procedures and requirements, including compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act and public participation requirements.

Stay Informed

The State Water Board will separately publish an agenda for a future meeting at which it will consider a proposed resolution to adopt the Review of State Plans and Policies. Oral comments at the State Water Board meeting generally will be limited to a summary of the written comments submitted during the written comment period. Persons interested in receiving notice of the meeting at which the State Water Board will consider adopting the Review of State Plans and Policies must subscribe to the Water Board's email distribution list.
