Notice of Board Meeting and Consideration of Adoption of California's 2026 Clean Water Act Section 303(d) List, and Notice of Availability of Proposed Final Documents and Response to Comments

The State Water Resources Control Board will conduct a public meeting to consider adopting the California Clean Water Act Section 303(d) list portion of the 2026 California Integrated Report ("2026 303(d) List" or the "List of Impaired Waters"). The 2026 303(d) List includes new proposed listings and delistings for waterbodies in the North Coast, Central Coast, Central Valley, Lahontan, Colorado River Basin, and San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Boards ("Regional Water Boards"). Background

Section 303(d) of the Clean Water Act requires each state to identify waters of the United States that do not meet or are not expected to meet, by the next listing cycle, applicable water quality standards and to prioritize those waters for development of a total maximum daily load, unless other corrective action is appropriate. Section 305(b)

of the Clean Water Act requires each state to report on the overall condition of its surface waterbodies (commonly referred to as the “305(b) report”). California combines its 303(d) list and 305(b) report into one “Integrated Report.” The State Water Board adopts the 303(d) list for California and submits it to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“USEPA”) for approval.

The 2026 California Integrated Report consists of assessments of waterbodies in the North Coast, Lahontan, and Colorado River Basin Regional Water Boards. Waterbodies within the San Joaquin River sub-area of the Central Valley Regional Water Board were also included. The San Joaquin River sub-area is defined as the San Joaquin River watershed and includes the mainstem of the San Joaquin River upstream of the legal boundary of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and all surface waters tributary to the mainstem. Some waterbodies in the regions of the Central Coast and San Diego Regional Water Boards are included as off-cycle assessments.

Approximately 419 new waterbody-pollutant combinations are recommended to be added to the 303(d) List, and 156 waterbody-pollutant combinations are recommended to be removed from the 303(d) List. An individual waterbody-segment may be impaired by one or more pollutants.
