I purchased a house in Los Osos and moved here in 1999. I am stretched with payments and am very worried about possible increases in monthly bills if the sewer system is built as initiated by the former CSD board.

I am appalled that the former CSD has, without sufficient assessments and votes by the affected citizens, been able to choose an outrageously expensive sewer system in the middle of town (which is an inappropriate site).

I also am very disappointed that the state made funds available to the former CSD board to begin this misguided project as a vote of mistrust was on the way and results were not known yet.

I believe such undemocratic and secretive actions were only possible through unethical actions by people who have their own agenda and do not care about Los Osos citizens, the existing water problems, and the financial implications the proposed project will bring with it.

When we recalled three (in my estimation - corrupt) board members and put three new CSD directors in place we hoped to have a chance for an affordable and sensible sewer treatment system. I fully trust the new board. They are people with the right

intentions, and most of all they are honest and possess integrity. I urge you to give them the chance they and the citizens of Los Osos deserve.

I also urge you to not be influenced by the continuing destructive behaviors by people like Roger Briggs and Sorrell Marks but to support the other faction of Los Osos citizens and the current CSD board who want to find affordable and sensible solutions.

Please support the Los Osos CSD in their effort to right what has gone wrong.
