KEY INFORMATION

Location: 1399 Olive Springs Road, Soquel, Santa Cruz County
Discharge Type: Quarry material process water and storm water
Capacity: 0.03 MGD
Treatment: Fines settling
Disposal: Discharge to Soquel Creek
Recycling: Discharges are infrequent due to extensive recycling with the quarry process
Existing Orders: NPDES Permit/Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 00-013

SUMMARY

The proposed Order is presented in the new statewide format for National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits. This standardized format presents the proposed Order with all supporting information appended as associated attachments. Consequently, the facility information and permit evaluation discussion normally contained within the staff report are presented in the Fact Sheet as Attachment F to the proposed Order.

This format was developed as a result of a statewide effort between the State Board, Regional Boards and USEPA to standardize NPDES permitting and compliance evaluation.
