**HEARING NOTICE: ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY COMPLAINT FOR FAILURE TO SUBMIT GENERAL INDUSTRIAL STORM WATER PERMIT ANNUAL REPORT; PAUL TRUCKING COMPANY, WATSONVILLE, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, WID# 3 44I013408**

Dear Mr. Webb:

Enclosed is an Administrative Civil Liability Complaint (Complaint No. R3-2006-0009) issued by the Executive Officer of the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) for failure to submit an Annual Report as Required by the General Industrial Storm Water Permit.

Should Paul Trucking Company choose to waive its right to a public hearing, an authorized agent must sign the waiver form attached to the Complaint, and return it to the Water Board no later than February 10, 2006. Should a hearing be necessary, it will occur on February 10, 2006, in the City of Salinas. At that time, the Water Board will hear public testimony and decide whether to affirm the action of the Executive Officer as described in the Complaint, or refer the matter for judicial civil action.

Please note that comments and other written submissions are due by 5 pm on Friday, January 6, 2006. Written material received after the due date will not be provided to Board members or become part of the record, unless the Chair rules that exclusion would create a severe hardship and that no party (including Central Coast Water Board staff) will be prejudiced by the late submission. The Chair will rule at or before the hearing. Late submissions that consist of evidence (as opposed to policy statements or comments) will generally be deemed prejudicial unless all designated parties (see below) have time to consider the evidence before the meeting.

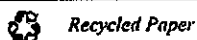

Storm Water Permit Violations

#### YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE THAT:

1. Paul Trucking Company (144 W Lake Ave., Watsonville, Santa Cruz County), is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region (hereinafter, Water Board), may impose civil liability pursuant to Section 13399.33 of the California Water Code (CWC).
2. Unless waived, a hearing on this matter will be held before the Water Board during a public meeting on February 10, 2006 that begins at 8:30 a.m., in Salinas, California. You and/or your representative(s) will have an opportunity to be heard and to contest the allegations in this Complaint and the imposition of civil liability by the Water Board. An agenda for the hearing will be mailed to you not less than ten days before the hearing date.
3. At the hearing, the Water Board will consider whether to affirm or increase the proposed administrative liability, or whether to refer the matter to the Attorney General for recovery of judicial civil liability, or any other action appropriate as a result of the hearing.
4. The State of California has adopted a General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity, Water Quality Order No. 97-03-DWQ, NPDES No. CA000001 (General Permit). The General Permit requires facilities to submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) to comply with the General Permit if the facility presents an exposure threat to storm water runoff as prescribed by the General Permit.
5. On September 11, 1997, Paul Trucking Company (hereinafter Discharger) filed an NOI to comply with the terms of the General Permit. By filing an NOI, the Discharger agrees to comply with all terms of and conditions of this General Permit, which includes submittal of an annual report to the Water Board.

6. The General Permit requires the discharger to submit an annual report to the Water Board by July 1 of each year. On August 10, 2005 the Water Board issued a Notice of Violation for failure to submit this report as required by California Water Code (CWA) Section 13399.31. On September 14, 2005 the Water Board issued a second Notice of Violation to the Discharger as required by CWC Section 13399.31. More than 30 days have passed since the second Notice of Violation.
7. The Discharger is in violation of the General Permit and California Water Code Section 13399.31 for failure to submit an annual report and is subject to penalties put forth in California Water Code Section 13399.33
8. Section 13399.33(c) of the California Water Code provides that a person that fails to submit an annual report in accordance with Section 13399.31, shall be civilly liable in an amount that is not less than \$1,000.

**Recommended Civil Liability:** On March 19, 2004, Paul Trucking Company was found by the Water Board to be in violation of the General Permit and California Water Code Section 13399.31 for failure to submit the 2002-2003 Annual Report for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity (Administrative Civil Liability Order No. R3-2004-0027). The assessed liability for that violation was \$1,000. Considering the Discharger's past violation of the General Permit, the Executive Officer recommends a civil liability be imposed in the amount of \$5,000.

**WAIVER OF A HEARING:** The Discharger may waive the right to a hearing. If the Discharger wishes to waive the right to a hearing, please sign the attached waiver and return it, along with a check in the amount of \$5,000 (payable to the State Water Resources Control Board, Cleanup and Abatement Account). FOR  
ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY COMPLAINT  
HEARING AND PAYMENT**

HEARING

Unless you waive your right to a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be held before the Water Board within 90 days of receipt of this administrative civil liability (ACL) complaint. You or your representatives will have the opportunity to be heard and to contest the allegations in the ACL complaint and the imposition of civil liability by the Water Board. A hearing is tentatively scheduled for:

At the hearing, the Water Board will consider whether to accept or increase the amount of the proposed administrative civil liability.

WAIVER OF HEARING AND PAYMENT OF CIVIL LIABILITY

You may waive your right to a hearing. If you wish to waive your right to the hearing, you or a duly authorized person must check and sign the attached WAIVER OF HEARING form and pay the civil liability amount specified on the ACL complaint. Make a check or money order payable to "Regional Water Quality Control Board" and write the ACL complaint number on your check to assure correct crediting of your account. Do not send cash. A duly authorized person is defined as a principal executive officer of at least the level of vice president in a corporation, a general partner or the proprietor in a partnership or sole proprietorship, a principal executive officer or ranking elected official in a public agency, or a duly authorized representative.

If full PAYMENT and a signed WAIVER OF HEARING form are not received in this office within 21 days of the scheduled hearing, the matter will be placed on the Water Board's agenda for a hearing as stated above. If full PAYMENT and a signed WAIVER OF HEARING form are received in this office prior to the hearing, the hearing will not be held, and the violation will be resolved.

## WAIVER OF HEARING

- By checking this box, I agree to waive my right for a hearing before the Regional Board with regard to the violations alleged in Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R3-2006-0009. Also, I agree to remit payment for the civil liability proposed. I understand that I am giving up my right to be heard, and to argue against the allegations made by the Executive Officer in this ACL complaint, and against the imposition of the amount of civil liability proposed.
