**RESOLUTION NO. R3-2006-0027**

**ADOPTING FY 2006-2007 PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND EMERGENCY, ABANDONED, RECALCITRANT (EAR) ACCOUNT ANNUAL SITES LIST**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 6.75 of the Health and Safety Code authorizes regional boards and local implementing agencies to take corrective action at petroleum underground storage tank sites where unauthorized releases have occurred; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Water Resources Control Board has established administrative procedures for providing cleanup funds to regional boards and local implementing agencies, which include adoption of EAR Account Annual Site List in July; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Water Resources Control Board requested regional boards ask local implementing agencies to nominate petroleum underground storage tank sites for inclusion on regional EAR Account Sites Lists; and

**WHEREAS**, the Central Coast Water Board, by letter dated January 10, 2006, requested local implementing agencies within the Central Coast Region to submit recommendations for the annual sites list; and

**WHEREAS**, Central Coast Water Board staff used local implementing agency submittals and its own recommendations to propose an annual sites list; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held on March 24, 2006, in San Luis Obispo to receive testimony on the proposed annual sites list.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region adopts the attached 2006-2007 Region 3 EAR Account Annual Sites List; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Executive Officer is directed to forward the Central Coast Water Board's 2006-2007 EAR Account Annual Sites List to the State Water Resources Control Board for inclusion in the statewide list.
