**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION FOR THE SOUTH COAST
COMMUNITIES SEPTIC TO SEWER PROJECT PROPONENTS,
RESOLUTION NO. R3-2007-0095**

SUMMARY

The South Coast Communities Septic to Sewer project will eliminate the use of existing septic systems in the Rincon Point, Sandyland Cove, Sand Point Road, and Padaro Lane residential areas of eastern coastal Santa Barbara county. Through many successful efforts by the Carpinteria Sanitary District, Heal the Ocean, and the Santa Barbara County Environmental Health Services Department, these residential areas will be connected to a sanitary sewer that will convey domestic wastewater to the Carpinteria Sanitary District for treatment. Staff believes the project will improve water quality by eliminating domestic wastewater contributions to adjacent creeks, lagoons, and ocean waters.

Resolution No. R3-2007-0095 (Attachment) acknowledges and expresses appreciation for the work of the South Coast Communities Septic to Sewer Project proponents. This concerted effort from various agencies and groups facilitated the project's design, funding, and approval.
