
The Water Boards have begun an effort to update their Strategic Plan. All Regional Water Boards are conducting a series of forums to receive input from stakeholders and staff about what should be included in the plan update. Stakeholders recently provided their perspectives at a Statewide Strategic Plan Summit on March 12-13, 2007, concerning issues and trends relating to water quality and water rights. They identified key areas of focus for the Boards to consider in their planning for the next five years. Regional and State Water Board staff discussed plan update ideas on April 16-17, 2007.

The Central Coast Water Board will host a session on this Strategic Plan Update on June 6, 2007. The purpose of this session is to discuss the public's (stakeholders') perspective on the statewide Strategic Plan, and how to improve it. We would also like to know what you think about ideas we already received during the statewide summits. We will use small facilitated groups and ideas will be recorded and reported out to all session attendees. The proposed agenda for this discussion follows. The Central Coast Water Board invited a specific group of stakeholders to this June 6 meeting, made up of individuals representing a variety of stakeholder interests. The Central Coast Water Board is also inviting other individuals to come and observe the interactive discussions. Observers will be integrated into the discussions if space allows. If we are unable to integrate observers into the facilitated interactive discussions, those individuals may contribute ideas in writing by answering questions in the Strategic Plan Regional Meeting Workbook that will be available at the meeting and located
