WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 23, 2007, in San Luis Obispo to receive testimony on the proposed annual sites list.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region adopts the attached 2007-2008 Central Coast Region EAR Account Annual Sites List; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Executive Officer is directed to forward the Central Coast Water Board's 2007-2008 EAR Account Annual Sites List to the State Water Resources Control Board for inclusion in the statewide list.
