Staff proposes that the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 01-131 for Santa Cruz CSA #10, Rolling Woods subdivision's wastewater treatment facility. Santa Cruz County built a sewer collection system from the community to the regional wastewater treatment plant in Santa Cruz, thereby rendering the Subdivision's package plant redundant.
