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DISCUSSION

Violations Listing

Staff uses the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS) to track Water Board data, including violations and enforcement actions. Attachment 1 is a CIWQS list of violations by dischargers between April 1, 2013, and August 31, 2013. CIWQS has a sewer system overflow (SSO) module that provides tracking and reporting of such spills.

Significant or Notable Violations

California Men's Colony: There are again multiple violations for salts and chlorination byproducts. However, we expect the number of violations to decrease with the completion of the ultraviolet disinfection system in October 2013.

Paso Robles: Construction of the new treatment plant continues. Violations and MMPs will continue until the new plant is in service, which is expected to be in October 2015.
