**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the California Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region (Central Coast Water Board) staff will hold a public workshop and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) scoping meeting<sup>1</sup> to seek early input on the development and environmental analysis of a proposed amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin (Basin Plan) to incorporate maximum contaminant levels for disinfection byproducts and maximum residual disinfectant levels from the California Code of Regulations, title 22, as water quality objectives for surface waters and groundwaters designated with the Municipal and Domestic Water Supply beneficial use.

Early public consultation may include one or more scoping meetings.

During the meeting Central Coast Water Board staff will solicit comments on workshop materials and will consider this information prior to the decision-making process. Written comments will also be accepted following the meeting. Please see, "How to submit written comments," below.

## Background

The Central Coast Water Board is the lead state agency charged with the protection of water quality in the Central Coast region. The Basin Plan is the Central Coast Water Board's master water quality control planning document and was first adopted in 1975. The Basin Plan designates beneficial uses and water quality objectives for waters of the state within the Central Coast region, including surface waters and groundwaters. It also includes programs of implementation to achieve water quality objectives. The Basin Plan may be amended in accordance with California Water Code section 13240 et seq. The Basin Plan and amendments to the Basin Plan are adopted by the Central Coast Water Board and approved by the State Water Resources Control Board, the Office of Administrative Law, and the United States Environmental Protection Agency, where required. The current Basin Plan was adopted by the Central Coast Water Board in June 2024.<sup>2</sup>

## **Purpose of CEQA Scoping**

The purpose of CEQA is to identify significant adverse environmental impacts, if any, associated with a particular action carried out or approved by a public agency (in this case, adoption of the proposed Basin Plan amendment), and how to avoid or mitigate those impacts, if feasible. CEQA scoping is an effective way to identify and resolve concerns of affected public agencies and interested persons. This meeting will provide participants with:

- 1) an explanation and understanding of the proposed Basin Plan amendment under development;
- 2) an opportunity to comment on the proposed Basin Plan amendment; and
- 3) an opportunity to comment on the appropriate scope and content of the environmental information to be included in a draft Substitute Environmental Documentation pursuant to CEQA<sup>3</sup> and the Central Coast Water Board's CEQA certified regulatory program for water quality control plans.<sup>4</sup>

Accordingly, the CEQA scoping meeting will help Central Coast Water Board staff in developing the proposed Basin Plan amendment; identifying what, if any significant,

unintended adverse environmental impacts could occur; and identifying alternatives that could reduce or minimize any significant, unintended adverse environmental impacts.
