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ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; PORT OF STOCKTON, PORT OF STOCKTON 5-YEAR PROGRAMMATIC MAINTENANCE DREGING PROJECT (WDID#5B39CR00268A1), SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

This Order responds to the 17 November 2022 request for an amendment of the Port of Stockton 5-Year Programmatic Maintenance Dredging Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B39CR00268). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 22 April 2016. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The Port of Stockton is requesting a time extension through 21 December 2022 to complete dredging for the 2022 year. A time extension was authorized by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) on 3 December 2022.

The Port of Stockton has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2016-00220) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 21 December 2022.

The Certification is amended as shown below:

For the year 2022, the in-water work window for maintenance dredging under the Project will be extended until 21 December 2022, or as otherwise authorized by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW). This amendment is only valid with simultaneous approval from both USACE and CDFW.

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$600.00 for the original Certification were received on 29 February 2016.
