ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; KAWEAH DELTA WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, HANNAH RANCH CHECK STRUCTURE PROJECT (WDID NO. 5C54CR00121A1), TULARE COUNTY

This Order responds to the 27 July 2026 request for an amendment of the Hannah Ranch Check Structure (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID No. 5C54CR00121). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 3 August 2021.

The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification. This amendment is not valid until and unless an amendment to the Section 404 Permit with equivalent modifications is approved by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) or it is otherwise determined by USACE that an amendment of the 404 Permit is unnecessary.

AMENDMENT:

The Certification is amended to change the expiration date from 3 August 2026 to 15 March 2031. The time extension will allow Kaweah Delta Water Conservation District to proceed with the Project described in the original Certification.
