TRANSMITTAL OF ORDER RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, CITY OF MODESTO AND BAY CITIES PAVING & GRADING, INC. CONSTRUCTION DEWATERING FOR NEW ROUTE 132 DRAIN SECTION, STANISLAUS COUNTY

On 12 June 2020, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's Water Quality Order 2003-0003-DWQ, *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality*, (General Order) for discharge to land from construction dewatering at the above-referenced project.

Your Notice of Termination, dated 31 August 2021, states that no further discharges from the project will occur and you wish to terminate coverage under the General Order requirements. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0209 is hereby rescinded.
