RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY, CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, STANISLAUS RIVER PARTIAL BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS COUNTIES

On 17 July 2020, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (General Order; 2003-0003-DWQ) to the California Department of Transportation for construction dewatering.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination, dated 4 April 2022, stating that the project is complete and discharges to land have ceased. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0210 is hereby rescinded.
