RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER WATER QUALITY ORDER 2003-0003-DWQ, STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND WITH A LOW THREAT TO WATER QUALITY; PORT OF STOCKTON, SIERRA LOGISTICS CENTER; PROSPECTIVE LEASE PORTION OF SITE 47, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 12 August 2024, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) issued a Notice of Applicability (NOA) under State Water Resources Control Board's Water Quality General Order 2003-0003-DWQ (Low Threat General Order), for construction dewatering. The Discharger was assigned enrollee number **2003-0003-DWQ-0247**.

The Central Valley Water Board received a Notice of Termination dated 16 June 2026 stating that the discharges to land for this project have ceased. Based on the submitted information, coverage under Order 2003-0003-DWQ-0247 is hereby rescinded.
