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WAIVER OF REPORT OF WASTE DISCHARGE AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC TYPES OF DISCHARGES WITHIN THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION RESOLUTION R5-2013-0145-0062, ELK GROVE CREEK MAINTENANCE PROJECT, SACRAMENTO COUNTY

On 25 August 2016, the City of Elk Grove (Applicant) filed a Report of Waste Discharge (RWD) for requesting coverage under *Waiver of Reports of Waste Discharge and Waste Discharge Requirements for Specific Types of Discharge within the Central Valley Region*, Resolution R5-2013-0145 (Waiver). After review of the RWD and the supplemental material submitted by the Applicant, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has determined that the placement of dredge materials associated with this project qualifies for enrollment under this Waiver. Per the application package, there will be no discharge to surface waters, work will occur in dry conditions, and the placement of the dredged material does not threaten to degrade or impair beneficial uses of the receiving waters.

Therefore, the discharge to land, as described in the RWD, qualifies for coverage under Category 3 as described in the Waiver. You are hereby assigned R5-2013-0145-0062 for the discharge to land. Please include this number on all correspondence related to this discharge.

The in-water work associated with this project is covered under Clean Water Act, Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5B34CR00044) issued to the City of Elk Grove for the Routine Storm Water Maintenance Project.

The project must proceed in accordance with the conditions specified in Waiver R5-2013-0145, and with the terms of the project description specified in the RWD. Coverage under the Waiver is no longer valid if the project as described in the RWD is modified.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The proposed maintenance dredging will remove a maximum of 3,600 cubic yards of material from Strawberry Creek, Elk Grove Creek, Grant Line Channel and Elk Grove Channel. The dredged sediment is planned to be removed by mechanical excavator, and transported by truck for placement immediately east of the Discharger's Special Waste Collection Center, located at 9255 Disposal Lane in Elk Grove.

APPROXIMATE TIMEFRAME OF PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION:

9 September to 1 October

PROJECT LOCATION:

Strawberry Creek, Elk Grove Creek, Grant Line Channel and Elk Grove Channel.
