On 19 August 2022, Chevron USA, Inc. submitted a Notice of Intent to obtain coverage under the Waiver of Report of Waste Discharge and Waste Discharge Requirements for Specific Types of Discharge within the Central Valley Region, Order R5-2018-0085 (the Waiver). The submittal contains all the information required to evaluate the applicability of the Waiver; therefore, the NOI is considered complete and the discharge meets the conditions of the Waiver. The discharge is hereby covered under the Waiver, Order R5-2018-0085-0076. Please include this number on all correspondence related to this discharge.

Project Location and Description

Chevron USA, Inc. (Discharger) is constructing a new gas station, car wash, and convenience store located at 1222 West Atherton Drive in Manteca, San Joaquin County. During excavation activities to install underground piping and fuel storage tanks, groundwater was unexpectedly encountered at approximately 10-15 feet below ground surface. The Discharger is requesting to discharge approximately 5,000 to 7,000 gallons of water for approximately two days to neighboring agricultural land with permission from the land owner. The discharge will remain on site and shall not impact any surface water bodies.

The Water Quality Control Plan for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins, Fifth Edition, revised May 2018, establishes water quality objectives, contains implementation plans and policies for protecting waters of the basin, and incorporates

by reference plans and policies adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board. Pursuant to §13263(a) of the California Water Code (CWC), waste discharge requirements must implement the Basin Plan.

Facility Specific Requirements

Please review the attached waiver documents and ensure that the discharge complies with the Conditions of Discharge contained in Attachment A of the waiver. Manteca Development Group and Chevron USA, Inc. are responsible for compliance with the waiver and must provide sufficient oversight to ensure compliance and prompt reporting of any noncompliance.
