Response to Written Comments on
Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for

American Avenue Disposal Site
Fresno County

At a public hearing scheduled for 20/21 June 2024, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) will consider adoption of tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the County of Fresno (Discharger), American Avenue Disposal Site, Fresno County for continued operations, monitoring, and corrective action. This document contains responses to written comments received from interested persons and parties in response to the tentative Order. Written comments from interested parties were required to be received by the Central Valley Water Board by 3 May 2024 in order to receive full consideration.
