NOTICE OF TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR BAR NONE AUCTION, BAR NONE AUCTION PROJECT, SACRAMENTO COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for the Bar None Auction Project (Project) in Sacramento County.

The 47-acre Project will construct an auction sales lot, which will consist of paved and gravel storage areas, stormwater basins, and an office building and industrial maintenance shop. Grading of the Project site will permanently impact 3.82 acres of seasonal wetlands.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) meeting scheduled for:
