Tentative Amending Order Information

The City of Brentwood (Discharger) is the owner and operator of the City of Brentwood Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility), located at 2251 Elkins Way, Brentwood, CA 94513. The Facility provides sewerage services for the City of Brentwood, serving a population of approximately 64,870. The Facility discharges an average dry weather flow of 5.0 million gallons per day (MGD), and 6.4 MGD upon completion of the Phase II Facility Expansion Project, of tertiary treated municipal wastewater to Marsh Creek, a water of the United States, within the legal boundary of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. The Discharger also conveys Title 22 disinfected tertiary treated recycled water to irrigation customers through the non-potable water supply system or via the recycled water fill station located at the Facility.

Discharges from the Facility are currently regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2024-0020 (NPDES Permit) and Time Schedule Order (TSO) R5-2024-0021, issued by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) on 19 April 2024. The NPDES Permit contains final effluent limitations for dibromochloromethane (DBCM) and dichlorobromomethane (DCBM). TSO R5-2024-0021 contains a compliance schedule and interim effluent limitations for DBCM and DCBM that expire on 30 September 2026. The Discharger has made diligent efforts to comply with the final effluent limitations for DBCM and DCBM but has demonstrated that additional time is needed to comply. Therefore, an amending Order is proposed to amend TSO R5-2024-0021 to allow additional time for compliance with these final effluent limitations until 31 May 2029.

Comment Period

Persons wishing to comment in writing on the proposed amending Order must submit such comments no later than 5:00 p.m. on **24 July 2026** to the Central Valley Water Board email at RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov. The Board may refuse to admit untimely written materials and shall refuse to do so when there is a showing of prejudice to the Discharger or the Board. Excluded material will not be considered.

Public Hearing

Any person may request an oral hearing before the Executive Officer. If no oral hearing is requested during the comment period, the public comment period and the Executive Officer's review of the administrative record, including any written comments, shall constitute the public hearing. Based on comments received, the Executive Officer may decide to hold an oral hearing or the matter will be considered at the Central Valley Water Board meeting scheduled for:
