The date, time, and location of the public meeting may change after this Notice is issued. A Final Agenda for the meeting will be made available at least 10 days before the meeting. The Final Agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date that the proposed order will be considered, and the anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

Opportunities to Comment

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to adopt the Order.

Written comments or evidence concerning the Order must be submitted by 5:00 pm on 16 March 2026. The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

Oral comments concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain designated parties may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The party subject to the proposed Order is/are designated parties. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water no later than 5:00 p.m. on 16 March 2026. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

Proposed Order

If adopted, the Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order will prescribe requirements for management of waste discharged from the Firebaugh Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF), located at 8000 Helm Canal Road, Firebaugh CA 93706. The WWTF is owned by and operated by the City of Firebaugh (City or Discharger). The Discharger will be responsible for maintaining compliance with Order requirements. The WWTF treats domestic wastewater from the City of Firebaugh and currently discharges wastewater to land via several evaporation/percolation ponds located on property owned by the City. Waste discharge from the WWTF is currently regulated by

WDRs Order 98-230. The WDRs are being updated to reflect the proposed WWTF upgrades the City will implement to improve effluent quality and provide biological nutrient removal. If adopted, the proposed WDRs Order will rescind and replace the current WDRs.
