**The date, time, and location of the public meeting may change after this Notice is issued.** A Final Agenda for the meeting will be made available at least 10 days before the meeting. The Final Agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date that the proposed order will be considered, and the anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

### **Opportunities to Comment**

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to adopt the Order.

The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

**Oral comments** concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain **designated parties** may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The parties subject to the proposed Order are designated parties. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water no later than 5:00 p.m. on 24 April 2026. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

### **Proposed Order**

The tentative Large Domestic General Order includes waste discharge requirements for domestic wastewater treatment systems with flows greater than 0.1 million gallons per day (Large WWTPs) that discharge treated wastewater to land within the Central Valley Region. The Central Valley Water Board currently regulates approximately 200 Large WWTPs through individual orders. If adopted, the Large Domestic General Order will provide an additional permitting mechanism for the Central Valley Water Board to issue waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for these and new Large WWTPs, thereby increasing permitting efficiency and consistency across the Region.


