The Triennial Review is a Clean Water Act requirement to review the Basin Plans every three years. Jessica and Mason enthusiastically stepped up due to the need to commence the project despite not working in the Basin Planning Program. Due to the delayed start, there was a strict timeline by which the Triennial Review had to be completed. Jessica and Mason diligently kept the project on this expedited timeline and ensured the Board's requirements were met despite many challenges. They both worked with stakeholders, Tribes, and the public that submitted comments, carefully thought through the comments and used them to develop the Draft Workplan, revise the Draft Workplan, and write a response to the comments.
