The public is invited to comment. Sierra Motor Sports requests no further action. Figure 1 is a map showing the location.

CASE SUMMARY:

The property is vacant after a fire in 2024. The property was an off-road vehicle dealer and repair shop. The building was demolished after the fire.

Soil was tested from the burned area next to the building. Lead, arsenic, and phthalate were found in soil. The lead, arsenic and phthalate are from ash created by the fire. Soil with the ash was cleaned up.

Ash and other debris were removed when the building was demolished. Removing the building, ash, and soil also removed the sources of lead and phthalate.

The property owner proposes no further action.
