**PROPOSED SITE CLEANUP CASE CLOSURE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**  
29 May 2026- 29 June 2026

#### PUBLIC NOTICE:

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is providing notice of a proposed No Further Action Determination at Wilbur-Ellis Co (212 Industrial Dr, Stockton) located in San Joaquin County. A map showing the location is included as Figure 1.

#### CASE SUMMARY:

Wilbur-Ellis Co operated at the Site from 1965 to 1992. Operations at the Site consisted of sales and distributions of packaged chemicals and fertilizers. The Site also contained a rinse water impoundment.

Testing detected the pesticide toxaphene and nitrate. Nitrate is commonly found in fertilizer. Areas at the Site that contained toxaphene and nitrate were excavated from the Site. The rinse water impoundment was also excavated from the Site. Two underground storage tanks (USTs) were found at the Site. One was excavated and one was closed in place. Samples of the soil near both USTs found low detection of total petroleum hydrocarbons.

The Central Valley Water Board is providing the public with an opportunity to comment on the request for No Further Action.
