The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin (Colorado River Basin Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment amended Time Schedule Order (TSO) R7-2020-0019-02, which concerns the following:

Oral Comments at Hearing

All persons interested in TSO R7-2020-0019-02 and/or this proceeding will be provided the opportunity to orally present general policy statements and legal arguments during the hearing, provided that they have submitted Speaker Request Cards (or the equivalent for virtual participation). Such comments will be limited to three minutes, though the Board Chair may grant additional time on a case-by-case basis.

To ensure accuracy of the record the Colorado River Basin Water Board requests that interested persons wishing to speak at the hearing provide a summary of their oral comments in writing before or during the hearing. However, interested persons do not need to submit written statements in order to speak.

If your comments will incorporate a short slideshow presentation or visual aids, please email these materials to Mary.Castaneda@waterboards.ca.gov no later than noon on the day before the meeting. These materials will not be admitted as evidence in the administrative record.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS

The Colorado River Basin Water Board will accept comments on TSO R7-2020-0019-02 during a 30-day public comment period ending on February XX, 2025. All written comments must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. Comments received prior to this deadline will be included in the administrative record. Untimely written comments will not be accepted, absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to the parties.

BACKGROUND

The Discharger owns and operates the Facility, located at 485 East Villa Road, El Centro, CA 92243, in Imperial County. The Facility is a steam electric generating facility that provides electricity to the Imperial Valley. The Facility consists of three steam turbine generators and three gas turbine generators, with a total of four generating units. All units are cooled using water circulated through unit-specific cooling towers. Colorado River water via the Dogwood Canal is used to provide water for cooling and other facility operations. The Facility discharges a maximum of 0.995 million gallons per day of

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industrial cooling water to Central Drain No. 5, which flows to the Alamo River, a water of the United States.

On January 16, 2020, the Colorado River Basin Water Board adopted Order R7-2020-0006 to regulate discharges of industrial wastewater from the Facility. Order R7-2020-0006 included effluent limitations for copper, lead, selenium, thallium, and zinc.

In March 2020, the Discharger reported that they were unable to consistently comply with the effluent limitations for copper, lead, selenium, thallium, and zinc established in Order R7-2020-0006 and requested a Time Schedule Order from the Colorado River Basin Water Board to allow sufficient time to bring the Facility into compliance with the effluent limitations.

On July 9, 2020, the Colorado River Basin Water Board adopted Time Schedule Order R7-2020-0019, which established a time schedule of no more than five years for bringing the waste discharge into compliance with the final effluent limitations for copper, lead, selenium, thallium, and zinc in Order R7-2020-0006.

TSO R7-2020-0019 was amended in August 2023 (TSO R7-2020-0019-01) to provide additional time to complete interim milestones and bring the waste discharge into compliance with the effluent limitations in Order R7-2020-0006 by April 1, 2025.

On August 19, 2024, the Discharger reported that they would not be able to meet the effluent limitations in Order R7-2020-0006 by April 1, 2025, and requested additional time. The Discharger stated they encountered unanticipated difficulty finding a primary construction contractor to complete their project.

The proposed amendment (TSO R7-2020-0019-02) will extend the deadlines for coming into compliance with the effluent limitations in Order R7-2020-0006.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS

The Colorado River Basin Water Board will accept comments during a thirty (30) day public comment period, which ends on **February 17, 2025**. Written comments on the TSO R7-2020-0019-02 must be received no later than **5:00 p.m.**, on **February 17, 2025**. Comments received by this deadline will be included in the administrative record. If written comments to the Colorado River Basin Water Board are not timely submitted, however, the Board Chair may refuse to accept such evidence or admit it into the administrative record unless the commenter can demonstrate why he or she was unable to timely submit the evidence, that compliance with the deadline would create an unreasonable hardship, or that allowing the evidence would not prejudice any party or the Colorado River Basin Water Board. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 23, § 648.4.) Written materials or other documents submitted at the Colorado River Basin Water Board hearing must be provided first to Board counsel, who will advise the Board regarding acceptance of these documents into the record.
