PROPOSED GENERAL ORDER FOR RECYCLED WATER USE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will hold a public meeting to receive comments on proposed Water Reclamation Requirements for Recycled Water Use (General Order). The State Water Board may adopt the General Order at the end of the meeting. The location and time of the public meeting is provided below.

BACKGROUND

The State Water Board is preparing a General Order for recycled water use. The General Order will be used by the Regional Water Quality Control Boards (Regional Water Boards) to streamline permitting of recycled water uses that are a relatively low threat to water quality. This General Order will replace existing *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Recycled Water Use* (order WQ 2014-0090-DWQ) adopted by State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) on June 3, 2014. The proposed General Order is intended to further encourage recycled water projects by: (1) acknowledging recycled water as a resource through water reclamation requirements; (2) allowing recycled water programs that are implemented in multiple Regional Water Board boundaries to be permitted by the State Water Board.

The source of recycled water allowed for coverage under this General Order is treated municipal wastewater. The General Order does not authorize potable reuses, but will allow uses of recycled water for beneficial uses such as irrigation of crops, dust control, and certain industrial processes. The General Order will allow the use of recycled water that meets the water recycling regulations and reuse criteria specified in the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 4, Chapter 3 (Uniform Statewide Recycling Criteria). The Uniform Statewide Recycling Criteria prescribes water recycling and reuse criteria protective of public health. When recycled water is used in compliance with the Recycled Water Policy, the Uniform Statewide Recycling Criteria ~~and other standards set by State or Regional Water Board for protection of public health~~, and all applicable state and federal water quality laws, recycled water is safe for approved uses.
