**NOTICE OF SECOND 15-DAY PUBLIC AVAILABILITY AND COMMENT PERIOD
OF ADDITIONAL CHANGES TO PROPOSED REGULATIONS REGARDING
REVISION OF WATERWORKS STANDARDS (R-14-03)**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.8(c), notice is hereby given that the Department has made additional changes to the text of the proposed regulations regarding the Revision of Waterworks Standards (R-14-03). This Notice for the Second 15-day Public Availability and Comment Period includes all proposed changes to date and is making the additional changes available for public comment prior to adoption, amendment or repeal of the resulting regulations. A copy of the proposed text with the new changes clearly illustrated is attached. (For the Internet posting of this notice, the regulation text is posted as a separate document in conjunction with this notice document.)
